Central Florida Community College CLAST Exemption Policy

Students are not required to attempt the CLAST before applying for an exemption.

Education majors are eligible for CLAST exemption for graduation purposes; however, they may need to take the CLAST or General Knowledge exam as an entrance requirement for their bachelor degree program.

CLAST exemptions are divided into two parts:

Part I: Exemption from the Communications subtests (reading, English & essay)

Part II: Exemption from the Computation (math) subtest

Part I

COMMUNICATIONS SECTIONS OF THE CLAST

(Reading, English Language Skills, Essay)

Students are exempt from the Communications CLAST subtests if they have achieved at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA in **both** of the following courses:

ENC1101 – Communication I (Comp I)

ENC1102 – Communication II (Comp II)

Students may also exempt the CLAST English, reading and essay subtests if they scored 500 or above on the Verbal section of the SAT-I. Students may exempt from the Reading subtest with a score of 22 or above on the Enhanced ACT taken after October of 1989**. Students may exempt from the English and Essay portion of the CLAST with a score of a 21 or above on the Enhanced ACT English test taken after October of 1989**.

(No specific college grades or English courses are required with the SAT or ACT exemption option) per F.S. 1008.29(9)(a) and F.A.C. 6A-10.0311.

Part II

COMPUTATION (MATH) SECTION OF THE CLAST

Students are exempt from the Computation (math) CLAST subtest if they have achieved at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA in **six hours** of designated college-level mathematics courses as listed below.

MAC1105 – College Algebra, or any MAC course with the last three digits higher than 102.

MGF1106 – Math for Liberal Arts I, or any MGF course with the last three digits higher than 106.

STA2023 – Statistics, or any other STA course.

Students also may exempt the Computation CLAST subtest if they scored 500 or above on the Quantitative Section of the SAT-I or 21 or above on the Math section of the Enhanced ACT taken after October 1989**. (No specific college grades or math courses are required with the SAT or ACT exemption option) per F.S. 1008.29(9)(a) and F.A.C. 6A-10.0311.

STUDENTS WHO PREVIOUSLY FAILED ANY CLAST SUBTESTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR CLAST EXEMPTIONS IF THEY MEET THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED ABOVE.

Coding for CLAST exemptions are as follows: ACT 996, SAT 997, GPA 998, special exceptions 999

Students who meet CLAST exemption requirements must complete an Exemption Application form and return it to CFCC's Enrollment Services Center on any CFCC campus. The Cashier's window on any campus will process the \$25 CLAST fee.
