What is dual enrollment?

An opportunity for qualified high school students to take college courses and earn both college and high school credit. Credits earned through the dual enrollment program may satisfy requirements for CFCC's associate degree programs and are transferable to other Florida public community colleges and state universities.



What are the advantages of dual enrollment?

- Accelerates a student's college career and provides a quality educational experience.
- Provides highly qualified teaching faculty who meet the criteria of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.
- Provides access to college resources, facilities and services.

How much does dual enrollment cost?

Quality instruction is provided at no cost to the student for approved dual credit courses. Textbooks are provided at no cost to public school students for approved programs.

Why is dual enrollment offered?

The program is a cooperative effort among CFCC and the school boards of Citrus, Levy and Marion counties to provide enhanced learning opportunities for qualified high school students. The program is authorized under Florida Statute 240.116.

Where are dual enrollment classes offered?

Classes may be offered at the student's high school, or at CFCC's Ocala, Lecanto and Chiefland locations, as well as online or through telecourses.

Criteria

- Student must meet all county articulation requirements.
- Student must submit a CFCC dual enrollment application, qualifying ACT/SAT/CPT test scores, and a transcript showing an appropriate high school GPA by the dual enrollment application deadline.
- Student must be 16 years of age and a junior or senior.
- Student must submit appropriate paperwork from the high school (dual enrollment application for public school students, letter of permission for private or home school students) by the application deadline.
